#### WHAT IS AN OSBF FELLOW?

An OSBF Fellow is a member of the Ohio State Bar Foundation—an attorney who contributes their time, talent, and treasure to advance the law and strengthen Ohio's justice system. Fellows give back through meaningful community service and a philanthropic component: each Fellow makes a pledge of \$2,500, which can be paid as a one-time gift or in installments over up to 10 years.

100% of Fellow contributions go directly toward OSBF grantmaking, which funds nonprofits across Ohio working to improve access to justice and increase legal understanding in their communities.

#### WHY BECOME A FELLOW?

The OSBF Fellows Program is a unique opportunity for attorneys to connect, collaborate, and make a lasting impact. Fellows come from diverse areas of practice and regions of the state and form lasting relationships through shared service, learning, and leadership. It's a meaningful way to broaden your professional reach while giving back to the legal system you serve.

#### WHAT WILL I DO AS A FELLOW?

As a Fellow, you'll spend the year building relationships with your Fellows class, giving back through community service, and participating in engaging, educational experiences that deepen your understanding of Ohio's legal system.

You'll also collaborate on a dynamic grantmaking session that directly supports initiatives that address unmet legal needs. As a class, you'll plan and present a symposium focused on a timely legal issue impacting Ohio communities.

To become a Fellow, you must first be nominated. Once nominated, you'll be invited to complete an application.
